

Using the FOI Act!

Training for new & experienced requesters

Central London Thursday 16 September 2010

Do you want to learn how to use the Freedom of Information Act? Are you already using the Act, but want to know more about how the Information Commissioner and Information Tribunal are interpreting key provisions?

The Campaign for Freedom of Information is running a day course for FOI requesters in central London on Thursday 16 September 2010. The course is in two parts. The **morning** part will provide an introduction to the legislation, covering both the Freedom of Information Act and the parallel Environmental Information Regulations. The **afternoon** will be more advanced and will cover some of the key decisions made under the two regimes and explain how they can help you obtain information. We think most requesters will benefit from attending the whole day, though very experienced requesters may prefer to attend just the afternoon.

Introductory (morning)

The morning course will explain:

- What information you are entitled to - and from whom
- How to make an effective request
- Key pitfalls and how to avoid them
- What authorities should do to help you
- When requests can be refused on cost grounds
- How the Act's exemptions and the public interest test work
- Challenging refusals

Advanced (afternoon)

The afternoon course will look at key Information Tribunal and Commissioner cases on issues such as:

- FOI requests for contracts
- Minutes of meetings with lobbyists
- Requests for civil service advice
- Names of officials - can they be withheld?
- Commercial confidentiality claims
- When requests for environmental information really pay off
- Arguing the public interest case

The courses will be presented by **Maurice Frankel**, the Campaign's director, who has worked for the Campaign since it was set up in 1984 and who is a member of the Ministry of Justice's Information Rights User Group and of the Information Tribunal User Group, and by **Katherine Gundersen** who has been the Campaign's research officer since 1999.
